General Information:

The utes will be judged by using a points system. The sum of the number of points accrued under each of the different judging criteria, will be the final Score Result. Only Utes entered in the same relevant category, will be compared to each other, with the highest scoring ute being determine as the winner of that category. (Criteria: Presentation / Accessories / Engine / Cab / Tray / Wheels = Total)

If possible, the judges ask and would prefer it, if the Owner/Drivers of the Utes could be in the vicinity of their vehicles during the judging assessment period.

“The Judges Decisions are Final”, and there will be no correspondence entered into.

- Best Ford Ute – Has to be a Ford Ute
- Best Holden Ute – Has to be Holden Ute
- Best 4WD Ute – 4WD ute of any make. Lift/Tyres/Recovery gear
- Best Chick Ute – Has to be owned/registered and driven by a female.
- Best Classic Ute – Has to be manufactured before 1980.
- Best Feral Ute – Rough and ready, dilapidated, unkempt, dents/rust/etc.
- Best Work Ute – Any Farm Ute or Tradies Ute with tools of the trade on board
- Best Street Ute – Clean presentation with no bullbar/spotties
- Best B&S Ute – Bullbar/Lights/Mudflaps/Aerials/stickers/B&S evidence
- Best Country Ute – Tidy Presentation with Bullbar/aerials and radios/spotties
- Champion Ute – General best stand out ute of the day.
- People’s Choice – will be the ute which scores the most likes from the general public.

Conditions of Entry:

- SA road rules apply both in and out of the showgrounds.
- All Utes must be road registered. If they are not registered, they must be brought to the muster on a trailer/truck and leave in the same manner.
- All Drivers must have a current driver’s licence and not be under the influence of Drugs or Alcohol. Anyone considered to be behaving in an inappropriate manner or under the influence of Alcohol or Drugs, will be disqualified from the Ute Muster and asked to leave the showgrounds.
- Relevant show speed limits must be adhered to, and all stewards directions must be followed.
 - Once the Utes are parked, they are not to be moved or leave the showgrounds until 4:00pm. (Subject to the discretion of the Muster organisers)
- Excessive noise and excessive revving are not permitted due to animals being in close vicinity.
- Burnouts, circle work and/or destructive driving behaviour will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- Any person not abiding by any of the above basic guidelines, will be disqualified from the Ute Muster, and asked to leave the Showgrounds.
- Photos may be taken of the utes in the muster and may include people in the photos. The Show Committee wants to notify you, that they may use some of these photos to promote the Show and Ute Muster, and are not limited to being used on Facebook, the website, and fliers etc. If you object to the use of photos of your ute and/or yourself being taken or used for promotional use, please notify the convenor at registration.

9:30am **Street Parade Registration.** To participate in the street parade, you can either register at the Show Grounds before 9:15am (recommended) or meet at the Pioneer Park (*South End of town on the intersection of Yorketown Road B89 and Park Terrace*). Please be aware that parade entrants will need to pay for show entry at the show gate prior to the parade or at registration and no further participants can be taken after 9:45am.

10:00am Street Parade

10:30am All vehicles onto the showgrounds and final registrations must be received by 10:30am for 11am start on the showgrounds.

2:30pm Awards presentations to be conducted from 2:30pm.

3pm A Parade on Elias Smith Oval will follow the presentation along with presentation of Champion Ute, People's Choice, and Rev Off for Loudest and Proudest Ute.
